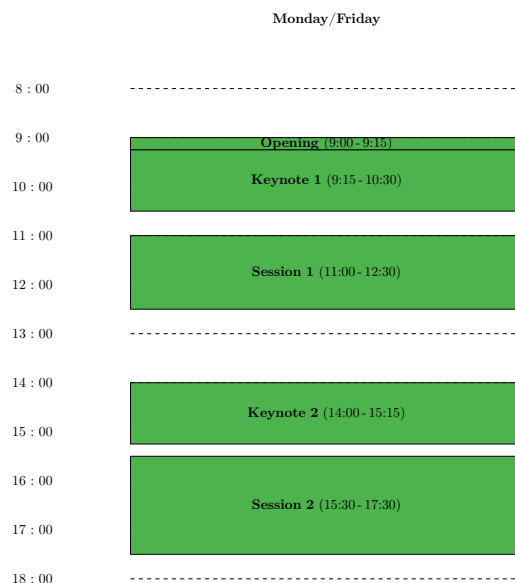


Figure 1. Tentative schedule.
